



Terms and guidelines for poster presenters:

- The poster should be printed out in portrait (vertical) style, as a single sheet, in the following size: **ISO DIN A0 format, width: 84.1 cm, height: 118.9 cm**. Posters must be prepared in advance by the presenters and brought to the congress printed for display. There is no opportunity for printing them at the Congress venue. **Please note: Due to fire regulations at the congress venue all posters must be printed on a hardly inflammable material!**
- The language of the congress and therefore of all posters and presentations is English. The title and the author(s)' name(s) should be included on each poster. Please also ensure it has a clear structure and is readable at a distance.
- Posters should be mounted between 09:00 and 10:00 AM on the first congress day (Wednesday, 5 September 2018). They can be removed on the second congress day, (Thursday, 6 September 2018) after 04:00 PM
- After your arrival and at the beginning of the congress, please check in at the registration desk and place your poster according to the number assigned to it. The numbers assigned to all posters will be presented at the congress website (see tabs "Congress" and "Program") just before the first congress day. They will also be posted at the venue, on the notice board near the registration desk.
- Fixing material will be provided by the organizers.
- The posters will be on display for attendees to view in the assigned area throughout the full congress. During the poster session **on Thursday, 6 September 2018, at 02:00 pm**, all presenters are kindly asked to stand next to their posters and be available for questions.

- Please note that it is your responsibility to remove your poster after the congress. All posters will be cleared away and destroyed by the organizers after the congress.
