

**Dr. Milu Muyanga** as an assistant professor of international development in the Department of Agricultural, Food and Resource Economics, Michigan State University. His research focuses on agricultural land, sustainable agricultural intensification, agricultural markets analysis, and poverty dynamics. He has projects in Tanzania, Kenya, Malawi, Zambia, and Nigeria.
