Rocco Barazzoni is Associate Professor of Internal Medicine at the University of Trieste, Italy, consultant in Internal Medicine and coordinator for the Obesity and metabolic syndrome Outpatient Unit at Trieste University Hospital. He has been General Secretary of ESPEN 2012-2016, and co-chairman of the ESPEN Special Interest Group on Obesity since 2014; he has recently been elected ESPEN Chairman 2018-2022, effective after the 2018 ESPEN Congress in Madrid. Previously member of the Italian Obesity Society (SIO) Executive Board, Professor Barazzoni is currently head of SIO national Scientific Committee. He has participated in the Editorial Boards of Diabetes, Current Opinion in Clinical Nutrition and Metabolism, Clinical Nutrition Experimental. His research focuses on nutritional and hormonal regulation of energy metabolism and mitochondrial function, oxidative stress, inflammation and insulin resistance in both clinical and experimental models in the settings of obesity, its metabolic complications and malnutrition. Professor Barazzoni has published 112 papers on these topics in international peer-reviewed journals, including original research as well as editorials, consensus and position papers and guidelines.
