

Professor Dr. Stephan C. Bischoff is Managing Director of the Institute of Nutritional Medicine at the University of Hohenheim in Stuttgart/Germany. He studied Medicine in Mainz/Germany and Strasbourg/France. In 1989 he received his approbation and his M.D. degree. After a postdoc time at the University of Berne/Switzerland in the Department of Clinical Immunology, he moved to the Department of Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Endocrinology at the Hannover Medical School/Germany. He received specialist degrees in Internal Medicine, Gastroenterology, Allergology and Nutritional Medicine. Until 2004, he worked at the Hannover Medical School and University hospital as Consultant and Assistant Professor. In 2002/03, he went for a sabbatical to the Columbia University in New York. In 2005, he was appointed Full Professor and Chair of Nutritional Medicine at the University of Hohenheim. Since 2010, he is Editor of the „Aktuelle Ernährungsmedizin“ (Thieme) journal. From 2012-14 he was President of the German Society of Clinical Nutrition (DGEM). From 2014 on he is the guideline officer of the European Society of Clinical Nutrition (ESPEN). His major research interests are obesity and related diseases, disease-related malnutrition, adverse reactions to food and mast cell biology, the gastrointestinal barrier and the microbiome.

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
