Before joining the University of Bologna, she worked for 11 years in ASTER, the Emilia-Romagna Agency for innovation, where she engaged on European networking, innovative technologies, industry-academia collaboration and start-ups, regional development. She also regularly served as expert for the European Commission in Framework Programmes since 2004.
